

**3. FEES FOR CERTIFICATE OF POLLUTION
PREVENTION LIABILITY
- LEVIED BY KOREA MARINE ENVIRONMENT
MANAGEMENT CORPORATION(KOEM) -
(COMPULSORY RATE effective from 1st January, 2015)**

(1) TABLE 1 OF FEES FOR CERTIFICATE OF POLLUTION PREVENTION LIABILITY(in case shipowners unable to arrange oil recovery boat)

1) Tankers

14.32 Korean Won per ton each voyage

* Application : Vessels(more than 500 GRT) carrying gasoline and/or liquid oil defined by article 2 of Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage Guarantee Act

2) Vessels other than tankers

7.45 Korean Won per ton each voyage

* Application : Vessels(more than 10,000 GRT) not belonging to Tankers

□ General Provisions

1) The shipowner shall make payment of the fee(table 1) unless disposition of prevention and response ship, whenever the vessel calls Busan, Incheon, Daesan, Yeosu(incl. Yecheon), Pohang, Gwangyang(incl. Hadong), Ulsan, Onsan, Pyeongtaek, Dangjin, Gunsan & Masan Port.

However, if she calls again the aforementioned port or the other Korean port within 10 days after payment of the fee(table 1), the additional fees (tables 1 and 2) are exempted.

2) Voyage payment means payment of the fee for each voyage with one voyage as unit. Annual payment means payment of the fee for (10) voyages in advance in a year. After the annual payment, she calls more than ten (10) frequencies during the period, no extra charge will be added

to the prepaid fee.

- 3) Transit vessel except tankers calling open ports for repairing, bunkering, supply of spare parts, crew repatriation/joining/temporary landing and etc. (departure within 24 hours) 80% reduction of the basic rate.

(2) TABLE 2 OF FEES FOR CERTIFICATE OF STOCKPILING OF THE CHEMICAL MATERIALS(in case shipowners unable to stockpile chemical materials etc.)

□ General Provisions

- 1) The shipowner shall make payment of the fee (table 2) unless keeping of materials and chemicals for prevention/removal of discharged wastes such as oil etc., whenever the vessel's calling Korean port other than Busan, Incheon, Daesan, Yeosu(incl. Yecheon), Pohang, Gwangyang, Ulsan,

Onsan, Pyeongtaek, Dangjin, Gunsan & Masan Port.

If she calls again the aforementioned ports after payment of the fee(table 2), she has to pay the additional fee(table 1). However, if she calls again within 10 days the Korean other port except the above ports after payment of the fee(table 2), the additional fees are exempted.

- 2) Voyage payment means payment of the fee for each voyage with one voyage as unit. Annual payment means payment of the fee for 10 voyages in advance in a year. After the annual payment, if the shipowner's vessel calls less than 10 voyages during the one year, a portion of the fee equivalent to the number of voyages short of 10 will be refunded to the shipowner. However, if she calls more than ten frequencies during the period, no extra charge will be added to the prepaid fee.
